

# The Great Ocean Road

Recognised as one of the world's classic ocean drives, the Great Ocean Road tour will take you through some of Australia's best farming country, along the magnificent Great Ocean Road with a choice of following the coast through South Australia or visiting Penola, the Saint Mary McKillop town. Total distance for this tour is approx. 1,800km

**Day 1** we leave Adelaide and head down the Princess Highway and via Horsham in Victoria to arrive at Halls Gap in the Grampians for our overnight stay.

**Day 2** is spent traveling through Western Victoria and some of the most beautiful farming country in Australia. The destination for this evening will be Lorne, the start of the most spectacular section of the Great Ocean Road.

**Day 3** - The Great Ocean Road, this is where the photographers will have a ball. There are so many places to stop and just enjoy the magnificent coastal scenery, the cliffs, the rain forest and more. By late afternoon we will be at Port Campbell and well deserving a quiet night.

**Day 4** and we continue to follow the coast through some of the beautiful coastal towns. It won't be a long day but there will be lots of places to see as we make our way towards Nelson at the mouth of the Glenelg River or Mount Gambier for tonight's camp.

**Day 5** will see us on the way home. On the way we will visit Penola, the town associated with Australia's first saint, Mary McKillop, then on through the lovely seaside town of Beachport and Robe as we make our way towards the Coorong then home to Adelaide.
