

Kangaroo Island

Still remote, a place where it's possible to drive for half a day and not see another car. KI's not known for nightclubs and disco's but photo opportunities and wildlife abound around every corner. Some great isolated camp sites available and some unique cafe's and restaurants. Even though it's a small island the tour will be around 450km by the time we return you to your transport back to Adelaide*.

Day 1. We will pick you up at the ferry or airport. We head east to do a conducted lighthouse tour of the majestic Cape Willoughby Light, South Australia's first lighthouse. We then proceed to Kingscote via American River, look at some history and have fun watching the pelicans being fed. A night time penguin tour is available for those interested.

Day 2. A busy day as we visit The Honey Farm, The Eucalyptus Distillery, Seal Bay, Vivonne Bay, Kelly Hill Caves, Hanson Bay, the koala walk and finish our day in a remote camping site in Flinders Chase National Park.

Day 3 and today we tour the north coast of KI. We drop into Cape Borda, a square lighthouse, check out the massive cliffs of the North Coast, visit some remote beaches that are hidden from the world, visit a fascinating wildlife park before camping for the night in Kingscote.

Day 4 and a chance to pick up some souvenirs in Kingscote, have a visit to American River, stop off for lunch at a wild south coast beach to before heading back to the ferry or airport so you can be back in Adelaide before dark.
