

# Wines & Mines

A look at some of the iconic South Australian locations in one of our most popular tours. If we follow the planned tour the 3 days of sight seeing and visits will be covered in around 500km.

**Day 1** and the Barossa Valley is our destination for the day, We can go via the Big Rocking Horse, Birdwood Mill National Motor Museum and Heibig Family tree or, if wineries are more your interest, straight to the Barossa. After we've visited a couple of wineries, we'll be heading to Clare to stop for the night.

**Day 2** and a morning visit to the unique Seven Hills Monastery Winery before visiting Martindale Hall (the school in the film "Picnic at Hanging Rock" ), Mintaro Maze and Mintaro Water Gardens. We'll also drop in to a couple of other wineries if you would like to try some more local vintage. From here we track north to Burra, the old Copper Mining town that was once bigger than Perth or Brisbane. It will be late when we get to Burra and time to settle for the night. Here we can stay in a caravan park or bush camp.

**Day 3** is an opportunity to explore Burra, it has some fascinating history and the Burra heritage Passport can easily keep one busy for the day. Burra main street and Redruth Goal were used as the film set for the movie "Breaker Morant". Mid afternoon we'll head back down the Barrier Highway to have you back in Adelaide before dark
